Overview:

Philadelphia is the world's largest outdoor art gallery - the city is home to more than 3,600 murals. In 1984, *Mural Arts Philadelphia* was founded to help eradicate graffiti and has since blossomed into a massive, city-wide project. Explore a small fraction of the murals Philadelphia has to offer on this combination of the two Mural Mile tours. Be prepared to walk!

Transportation:

To get to the mile starting point: Take the Market – Frankford Line to 15th Street.
To return to Penn: Take the Market – Frankford Line from 15th Street to 34th Street or 40th Street.

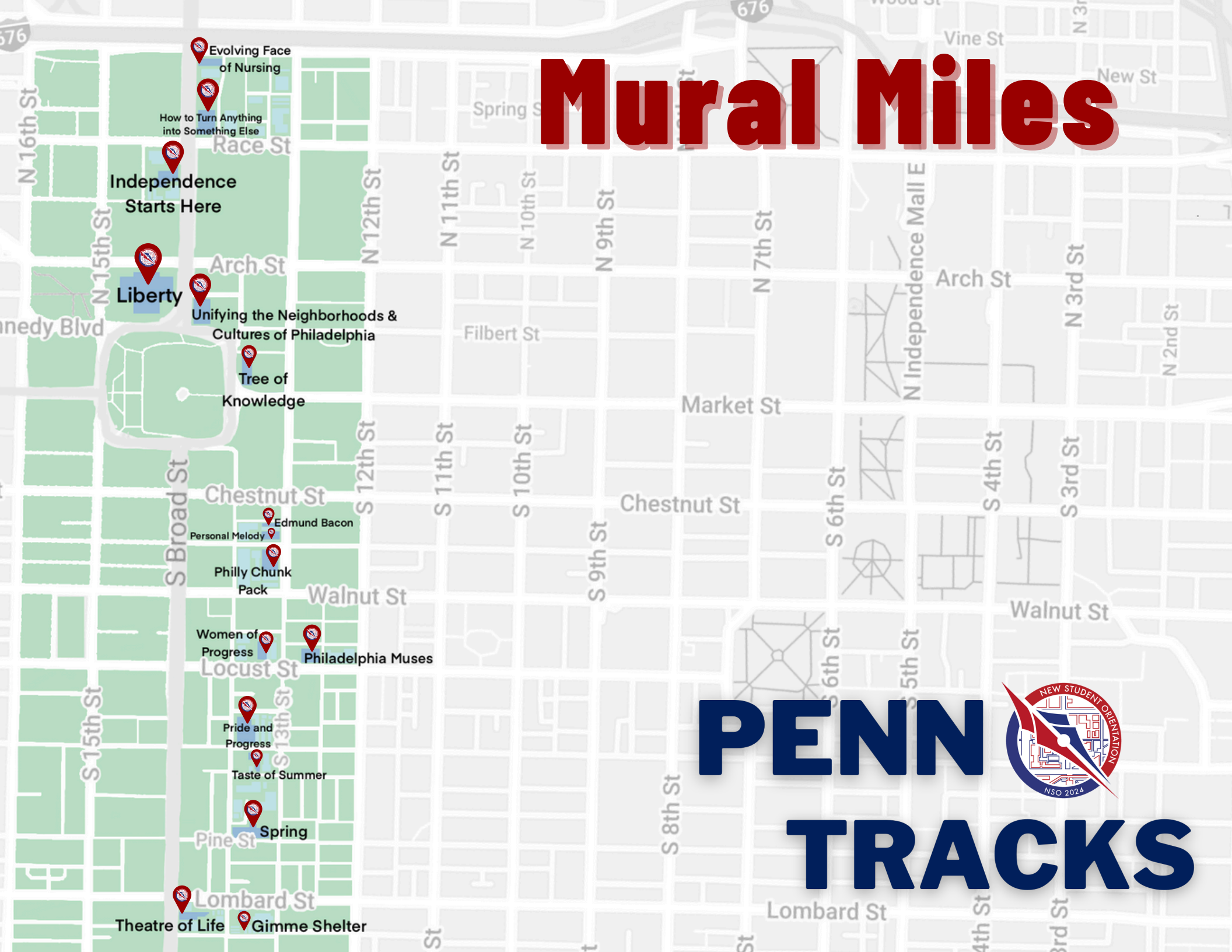

Mural Arts collaborates with communities on 50 to 100 public art projects annually and sustains its expanding collection through a dedicated restoration effort.

Each year, 15,000 residents and visitors take tours of Mural Arts' outdoor art gallery, which has become a cornerstone of Philadelphia's civic identity and a renowned source of pride and inspiration, solidifying the city's international recognition as the "Mural Capital of the World."
